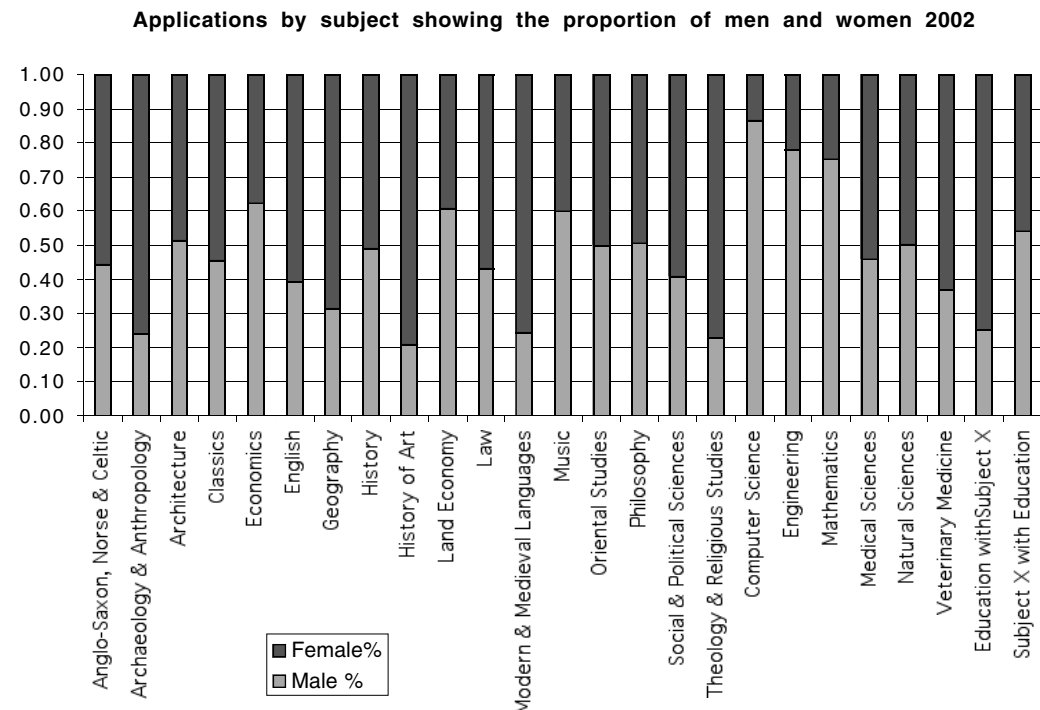

In Table 3 the three highest A level grades in all subjects, excluding General Studies, are used for scoring purposes. The A level scoring system is the old system (rather than the new UCAS tariff system) where A = 10, B = 8, C = 6, D = 4, E = 2.
