In Table 6, Primary College denotes the applicant's first choice College, or in the case of an Open applicant, the College to which the applicant was assigned. During the Winter Pool post-A level applicants (i.e. those who already have their examination results required for entry) may receive an unconditional offer of a place, and pre A level applicants (those who have yet to complete their entry qualifications) may receive conditional offers. During the Summer Pool applicants holding conditional offers that have not quite been fulfilled may receive an unconditional firm offer of a place at another College. The figures for Pool places and offers are for changes of College only. Particularly during the Summer Pool, Colleges also reconsider their own applicants.
