The University Flag will also be flown on Congregation days, including 1 October (Election and Admission of the Proctors and Address by the Vice-Chancellor) and the Honorary Degree Congregation.

Additionally, the Rainbow Flag will be flown on the first and last days of February (or on the nearest Monday or Friday as appropriate).

# **Resubmission of Grace (University Composition Fees)**

18 January 2021

On 13 January 2022, the Vice-Chancellor withdrew Grace 1 of 6 January 2022 concerning University Composition Fees (see p. 219). This followed a query from a member of the Regent House about the validity of the method of its submission to the Regent House, following its publication on the *Reporter* website. The Vice-Chancellor agreed to withdraw the Grace owing to the ambiguity of the wording of the relevant Ordinance about what constituted publication in the *Reporter* (see Regulation 2, *Statutes and Ordinances*, p. 103). The Council has agreed to resubmit the Grace in its original form, as permitted by Regulation 6 of the Ordinance on Graces and Congregations of the Regent House (*Statutes and Ordinances*, p. 105). It does not consider it necessary to call a ballot on the Grace, as the query related solely to process; no concern was raised about the substance of the Grace.

The Council will publish a Report in due course to propose changes to the Ordinance on the Cambridge University Reporter so that there is certainty about its meaning. It is submitting a Grace (Grace 1, p. 221) to amend the table of fees for 2022–23 as set out in the Schedule to its Notice dated 6 January 2022 (*Reporter*, 6642, 2021–22, p. 207).

# **Public Procurement Regulations: Correction**

In the Council's Notice published on 12 January 2022 (*Reporter*, 6642, 2021–22, p. 206), there was an incorrect reference to the relevant regulations. The Notice should have referred to the Public Contract Regulations 2015 (Directive 2014/24/EU) as amended by the Public Procurement (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020, not the EU Public Procurement Regulations.
